

PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Multiple train providers have services to Liverpool Lime Street including Virgin, London Midland, Transpennine Express and Northern Rail. Merseyrail's James Street or Moorfields stations are the nearest drop off points and all buses into Liverpool drop off at the Liverpool ONE bus station adjacent to the Liverpool Waterfront.

BY RAIL AND BOAT

The area is serviced by James Street station, and the building is right opposite Mersey Ferry terminal.

BY ROAD

Input postcode L3 1DS on SatNav or follow signs to the Waterfront, Albert Dock, Mersey Ferries and AA signs to the British Music Experience. There is limited on street parking around the attraction, and we are serviced by a range of car parks across the Waterfront.
