On Friday, Supreme Court Justice Ruth Bader Ginsburg died of complications from cancer at the age of 87. Journalists, commentators, former colleagues, politicians, and friends will have much to say about her extraordinary career and legacy in the days ahead. But just before she died, Ginsburg herself pointed to what will likely be the most urgent question for those who supported the causes that motivated her life's work: What will happen to her seat, which could tip the court to a hard-right majority for decades to come? As NPR reported, Ginsburg's final statement, dictated to her granddaughter Clara Spera from her deathbed, was simply: "My most fervent wish is that I will not be replaced until a new president is installed."
