FOOD WASTE PER PERSON 74.7kg (per year) 4,903,905,600kg (per year)

In the UK an app « Too good to go » directs it 1,8 M users to bakeries shops and restaurants just before they close, allowing them to pick up the day's surplus food at a bargain price.





FOOD WASTE PER PERSON 106kg (per year) 7,123,306,000kg (per year)

France was the first country in the world to prohibit supermarket's from throwing away unused food. Instead, supermarkets with a footprint of 400 square metres or more must now donate unused food or face fines of €3,750 (£2,900).


