

Satanic rituals, demonic possession: Revelations about Jeffrey Dahmer

Known as the "Milwaukee Cannibal", Jeffrey Dahmer committed 16 homicides from 1987 to 1991. Rape, dismemberment, necrophilia, cannibalism... everybody knows its history, or almost. On the occasion of the release of the serie "*The story of a monster*", we summarize its history and the secrets not revealed to the public...



A look back on the life of a "monster"

Jeffrey Dahmer is the most famous American serial killer. He was born in 1960 and was murdered by his fellow inmate after being sentenced to 957 years in prison in 1995.

As a child, he was described as "happy and energetic." However, he is passionate about a strange practice: he often goes to the forest and brings back dead animals to dissect them and collect their bones. His father, who works in the chemical industry, does not seem to be bothered by this. He even said that he thought it was normal since he was passionate about science himself. If the story ended here, we would just say that this poor child should have gone to the psychologist...

But, the rest of Dahmer's story was willingly hidden by the Americans.

In high school, Dahmer had no friends. While the students call him "crazy", the science teacher notices an *incredible potential* in him during a pig dissection. He seemed to know how to do it without anyone explaining it to him...

Strange coincidences ...

A few years before he was born, a man named David Roski and his entire family disappeared. He was sought after for 4 years. In 1972, a body was found hanging in the forest: After analysis, the American police assert that it was David's mutilated body, but his family couldn't be found. They found a letter in the pocket of his jeans: David wrote that he had eaten his parents and his sister. He explained that he was walking in the forest with his little sister. They stopped to drink in a small cave. David had felt a strange presence. He saw behind him a creature half deer half man. No sequel was written. The police had searched the forest but couldn't find any cave or monster. They then abandoned the investigation.

A paranormal specialist tried to take over the case. He analyzed the autopsy reports and the letter, then established a strange hypothesis: The description of the creature, the cave and the cannibalism reminded him of an old Indian myth. David would have been the prey of a demonic possession...the wendigo.

Cannibalism... strange to you know that the forest in question is the one where



Jeffrey spent his weekends collecting dead animals...It could be a coincidence but Dahmer's story brings us closer to this legend.

When he left home to live in the city with his grandmother, he refused to go to church. After his imprisonment, the police searched his room. They found a prayer altar with a deer skull and human bones hidden under the bed, those of his second victim, a man he met in a gay bar.

A horrendous legend:

This legend is shared by several Native American nations. The wendigo is a supernatural creature, evil. They live in the woods and look out for people who are lonely. They would then take over the body of their victim and control them. The victim would become malevolent and... cannibal.

Their characters undergo profound transformations and they become asocial and violent, being gradually controlled by the spirit and the horrible appetite of the wendigo that lives inside them.

The wendigo phenomenon has become more than just a myth, some psychologists call it "wendigo psychosis" when a patient shows signs of cannibalistic tendencies and exhibits violent and antisocial behavior.

So much in common with Jeffrey. Solitude, violence, cannibalism. Jeffrey must have had the same encounter as David in the forest.
